CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All entries <u>MUST</u> be registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of New Zealand (Inc.)
- All entries to be entered online
- Entry forms must be completed online and electronically signed personally by exhibitor who agrees to comply with Taranaki Welsh Pony & Cob Show Conditions of Entry and the Egmont A&P Showground Rules.
- Entry fees and box/accommodation fees must be deposited to account 15-3948-0311202-00by internet banking before closing date.
- 75% of Entry Fee which includes Stabling & Ground fees will be refunded on the presentation of a Doctors or Vets Certificate (minus Main Event compulsory fees)
- The responsibility for accuracy of the description or pedigree and for the eligibility of animals to compete rests entirely with the exhibitor
- In all classes where applicable the name of the pony, date of birth, sire and dam and Stud Book Number shall be given on the Entry Form.
- Purebred and Partbred Ponies & Cobs registered as geldings must be gelded with a Gelding Number
- All stallions or colts 1 year and over must wear a bit and have a stallion tag on bridle, a bib and be handled by a person 15 years or over.
- No Colt or Stallion to be tied to Truck or float at any time. Stallion/colt owners must book a box with their entries.
- The committee at its absolute discretion may refuse an entry or cancel any entry already accepted or decline to admit to the show grounds or remove any animal, exhibitor or person from the said grounds. There will be no refund of Entry Fees or Box or Showground Fees
- Foals under four weeks of age must not be exhibited.
- Foals to be led at all times
- The Judge's decision will be final.
- The committee reserves the right to make any alteration to the program or postpone or cancel the show as it sees fit.
- The committee will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may be caused to or suffered by any exhibit, exhibitor or spectator, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the committee indemnified against any claim in respect of any such accident, loss or damage. All persons and their property enter the grounds at their own risk
- Age of rider/handler as of day of show
- Handlers eight (8) years and under must wear a helmet & AT ALL TIMES and have an Adult supervisor accompany them who is not exhibiting in the same class
- All Handlers 13 years and under must wear an approved safety helmet when exhibiting in the ring
- All Dogs must be on lead at all times
- Registered Welsh Foals and Youngstock Purebred & Partbred are not to be clipped.
- Youngstock are to be three years and under at date of show.
- Trimming is permissible, throat, lower jaw, jaw line. Trimming of Muzzle (whiskers) is not permitted.
- All stables and yards must be left clean and tidy after use.
- Horses must not be left unattended overnight. There must be a designated person in charge at all times.
- An ID tag is required for all ponies left on grounds overnight with contact phone number.
- Leave gates as you found them.

RULES:

Under NZ Occupation Health & Safety it is the responsibility of **EVERYONE** on the grounds to ensure these rules are adhered to. The committee reserves the right to deal with anyone breaching these rules, which may include the removal from the grounds.

- Abuse will not be tolerated. Any abuse reported, the exhibitor may be asked to leave grounds. The Welfare of exhibits is paramount. No lame or sick animal to be bought into a class.
- The committee supports the "Horses and Donkey Code of Welfare 2018" https://www.mpi.govt.nz/dmsdocument/11003/direct

ABUSE OF EXHIBITS: The welfare of exhibits is paramount. Any complaints of exhibit abuse will be dealt with by the committee. Abuse can be defined as intentionally acting in a way, which may cause pain or unnecessary discomfort to an animal. As examples, but not limited to; i. Whip or beat an exhibit excessively ii. Subject an exhibit to any kind of electric shock device iii. Excessive or persistent use of spurs, or to jab the exhibit in the mouth with the bit. iv. Remount, or attempt to remount, an obviously exhausted, lame or injured exhibit v. 'Rap' an exhibit anywhere in or outside the grounds of the event vi. Hyper sensitise any part of an exhibit vii. Leave exhibit without adequate food, drink and exercise.

LEAD REIN:

- Judging criteria: 60% suitability, temperament and safeness. 40% conformation and paces.
- Riders minimum of 4yrs. Age is day of show
- Ponies to be led by a leader 14yrs and over with the lead rein attached to the cavesson noseband of a snaffle bridle
- · Running or bearing reins or similar tack is not allowed
- Spurs are not allowed. A cane or whip not exceeding 68cm in length which includes a flap 2cm wide by 4cm long, may be carried by riders
- · Ponies will be asked to walk and trot- no cantering_under any circumstances

FIRST RIDDEN:

- Judging criteria: 60% suitability, temperament and safeness. 40% conformation and paces
- Riders minimum of 4yrs. Age is day of show
- First Ridden Ponies must be ridden in a snaffle bridle with a cavesson noseband, snaffle bit and a single rein
- Spurs are not allowed. A cane or whip not exceeding 68cm in length which includes a flap
 2cm wide by 4cm long, may be carried by riders
- · All Ponies walk and trot no canter
- The same combination cannot enter in both the lead rein section and First Ridden section or in an open ring however a pony that has entered the Lead Rein can be entered in the First Ridden with a different rider (who is eligible to compete in this section)




